Our Academic Impact

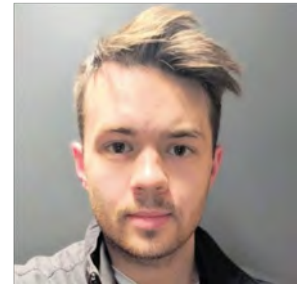
Here are a few amazing things the Students' Union has achieved in the past few months.
